Decisions taken during our MoU-meeting of 2018/05/07:

- Format: attractive and compact covering letter + formal MoU (preamble-articles-annexes)
- MoU to be signed by funding authorities (who should encourage their institutes to participate in the network). Usually dean of faculties sign for their physics departments; sometimes even higher level.
- Members of the network are committed to provide annually (?) the minimum data set defined by WP2 (should be described in an MoU-article)
- Find an umbrella organisation for the network (e.g. Science Europe)
- Try to get ERC to recognise the GENERA network (aside: I now remember that already for FP6 for grants, for large scale research infrastructures it was required to write a paragraph on diversity/gender; Who can check the current ERC grant application forms?)
