

(1) Goals Nikhef jamboree

1. Each Nikhef member is aware, at a high level, of the current state of the Nikhef program
2. Provide a platform for colleagues to present themselves and their work, and to hone their presentation skills

(2) Current situation

- A. A substantial fraction of the audience has their attention elsewhere, looking at a device (laptop, mobile phone) - PASSIVE
- B. The second day attendance is less than the first day, and people arrive late
- C. Students indicate that many presentations aren't understood outside of one's own group
- D. Presentation quality is not consistent

(3) Goal of this proposal

1. Audience involved in what is being presented
2. Less peak and off-peak effect (piek en daluren)
3. More presentations well understood by all attendees
4. The goals of the Jamboree are met

(4) Analysis - possible explanations

- A. Talk difficult to understand / Students too busy
- B. People come to the 1st day for their own group sessions and dinner, to the 2nd day only for their own group? Arrive late: make it late at dinner when you can skip the 1st session
- C. Partly the same as the first point, including that you need a long attention span to follow talks from 9 to 5
- D. Speaker skills: our colleagues do not receive any training in presenting

(5) Proposal

1. **The format is adjusted** - each program is reduced in time.
2. **Make a choice:** or use of laptops and cell phones outside in a separate room reserved for that purpose, or listen to talks inside with laptops and cell phones stored away
3. We ask program leaders to invite some **"outsiders"** during practice sessions for jamboree talks
4. **A mini-course** (1/2 day) on presenting is held before the jamboree
5. **Blind schedule** - PGL's notify speakers early on
6. **Jamboree theme** - Your *Eureka (Aha-Erlebnis)*
7. **New PhD introduction** - one minute carousel
8. **Moderator** (Martijn) - stimulate participation - students in front
9. **Program introduction** as guidance for rest of session
10. **Session prize** - group effort
11. **Survey** - did it work, breakdown attendees, input M&L workshop

(6) Options

1. **Lightning talks** - 5-minute presentations
2. **Parallel focus sessions** - Q&A - always wanted to ask (not attending your own group)
3. **Format slides** - 7, 14, 28 (min., max. slides, font size)
4. **Mystery sessions**

Info for Program Leaders

- **Blind program.** Check time allocated for your program; specific slot known on the day.
 - Why: facilitate all-hands aspect of Jamboree - all present for all sessions, including 'mystery' sessions
- **Jamboree theme:** Your *Eureka* (Aha Erlebnis)
- **Assign speakers.** In case PhD's let us know before 31-10-2019, they will be invited for mini-course.
 - Course is first half of November
- **Keep the audience in mind.** Font sizes, plot axes, level of detail, likely audience knowledge level, what should the takeaway message be? N.b. there will be a prize for the best session *Jamobeer 2019*.

Info for Program Leaders

- **Suggestions**

- **Invite an outsider** (colleague from a different group) for the talk practice session(s).
- Have an **introduction talk** with background / context / goal, other talks don't need to repeat this and can go straight to specifics
- Leave sufficient time (suggestion: 20%) for **discussion**. Speakers could end the talk with some points for discussion or even a question to the audience.
- A session does not have to (only) be a series of talks. **Other options** can be considered: a movie, no-slides presentations, Q&A session.
