

General announcement

The BND graduate school 2020 is a school intended for PhD students in experimental particle physics in the early phase of their career. It is part of the series of BND graduate schools, which are held annually, and rotate among organizing universities and institutes in Belgium, Germany and the Netherlands.

The BND graduate school 2020 will take place between Tuesday September 1 (lunch-time) and Saturday September 12 2020 (lunch-time), in Callantsoog, the Netherlands. Callantsoog is a quiet sea-side resort with a sandy beach, approximately one hour travel north of Amsterdam. Nearest train station is Schagen, on the line Amsterdam-Den Helder; information on transportation will be provided later. We expect students to arrive in the morning of September 1, and leave in the afternoon of September 12. The venue is in **Fletcher BadHotel Callantsoog**.

Students are expected to stay the full period of the school. The fee will be 1100 Euro, and covers all expenses: meals, lectures, excursions, and boarding in double rooms.

How to reach the venue:

From Amsterdam central station the trip takes about one and a half hours. You can board the intercity train in the direction of Den Helder (during day time 8 AM – 10PM in general you can expect one train every 30 minutes) and you should get off at the Schagen station.

From Schagen station takes just 1 minute walking time to be at the bus station and there you should board bus number 152. The bus takes 28 minutes to reach Callantsoog, Stuyvezandeweg stop. The stop is about 450 meters (5 min walking distance) from the school venue
