

Travel Advise

Dear Nikhef collaboration friends,

Below is some travel advise to make sure you are on time for the start of the Jamboree in Maastricht next Monday.

From Maastricht trainstation to the venue at the Vrijthof takes 20-25 minutes, almost the same when taking a bus or walking. If you take the bus take line 8 at the trainstation to the 'Markt' (stop Forum) and then walk the remainder to the Vrijthof.

If you walk just walk in a straight line out of the front exit of the trainstation, over the old maas-bridge, via the shopping streets (one left-turn + one right-turn) towards the Vrijthof square.

To be in time for the jamboree opening in the St Janskerk, we advice to plan your trip to arrive in Maastricht trainstation at either 9h30 (intercity) or 9h49 (local train).

Our apologies that this is quite early for people coming in from far, but in return you get an amazing jamboree starting with fresh piece of limburgse vlaai at the **opening at 10h00**.

For those who have not traveled frequently by Dutch trains and come from Amsterdam, please make sure you **do not start your train trip at Science Park**, since this takes way too long. We suggest to put your bike at Amstel Station and take the train from there.
