## WISE/SCI at EUGridPMA (28 Sep 2021)



- SCI-WG
  - Complete the HowTo Guidance on maturity assessment
    - & encourage Infrastructures to perform self-assessment
  - Produce updated policy templates from AARC PDK

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## Development of AARC PDK by WISE SCI-WG (Sep 2021)



- Involve the widest experience from many Infrastructures and policy groups
- Infrastructures using/considering the AARC PDK include
  - EOSC-hub, EOSC Future, IRIS(UK), EGI, ELIXIR, WLCG, SLATE(USA), FZJ, ...
- Policy templates are useful to new Infrastructures and help build trust and interoperability (compliant with SCI Trust Framework)
- WISE SCI will collect feedback from Infrastructures
  - And use this if/when a new version of a template is required
- Unlike AUP, new templates may contain optional components
  - Infrastructures just use the components that work for them
  - Or indeed have several different templates (loosely coupled, tighter, ...)

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## Which policies to work on first? (Sep 2021)



- Security of Service Operations
  - And EOSC Baseline security
- Community Operations
- Top-level Security Policy?
- Update the WISE Baseline AUP (a version 2)
  - Include input from Trusted CI
- Data Privacy (GDPR etc)
- Identity Management/Assurance

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## Policy Development Kit - Background



- In 2017 the AARC project highlighted Policy training as a priority, the AARC2 project tasked with providing it!
  - Interest from additional groups e.g. WISE, EUGridPMA
  - SCI refers to the need for multiple policies but no concrete examples provided
  - Research Communities were asking for help getting started with policies and related documents (this has continued...)
- Since then
  - Published PDK <https://aarc-community.org>
  - Agreed to be maintained by WISE
  - Practical experience gathered

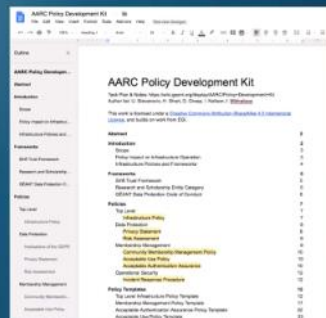


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## Policy Development Kit - Process



- Majority of structuring and editing by AARC participants
- Input from wider community through WISE and IGTF
- Members of EOSC-Hub policy task were “volunteered” to review individual policy templates

  - ...



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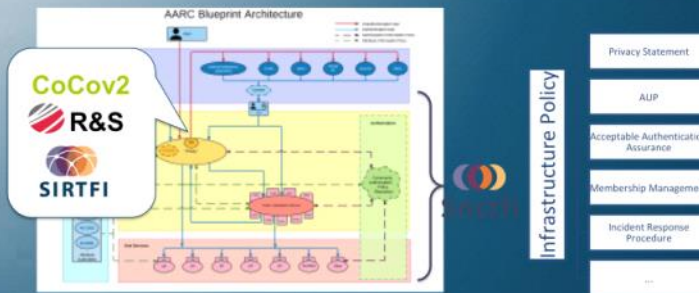
# Policy Development Kit - Content

Actually, the policies can be applied much more broadly as we will see...



The policies presented are relevant for an **Infrastructure operating a Service Provider Proxy** that represents the bound set of services in an identity federation. The policies are to be adopted by the Infrastructure itself and, where appropriate, additional policies are suggested for Infrastructure participants such as Services, User Community Management or Users. The Infrastructure may be for the sole use of a single **Research Community**, or may provide computing services to multiple Research Communities; the policies presented are designed to be **Reusable**.

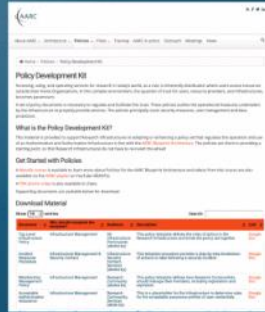

AARC PDK - 7 + 3 sub clauses, 417 words	IRIS - 10 clauses, 336 words	EOSC Baseline (as of 30/09/2021) - 13 clauses, 444 words
By running a Service, you agree to the conditions laid down in this document and other referenced documents, which may be subject to revision.  You shall comply with all relevant Infrastructure Policies [R1] 1. You shall provide and maintain accurate contact information, including at least one Security Contact who shall support Sirtf [R2] on behalf of the service.	Each Service Provider must  1. collaborate with others in the reporting and resolution of security events or incidents arising from their Service's participation in the Infrastructure and those affecting the Infrastructure as a whole (R3/R4).	All EOSC Service Providers, directly connected Identity Providers, and AAI Proxies, must  1. comply with the SIRTPI security incident response framework for structured and coordinated incident response  3. collaborate in a timely fashion with others, including the EOSC Security Team, in the reporting and resolution of security events or incidents related to their Service's participation in the EOSC infrastructure and those affecting the EOSC infrastructure as a whole.

  - Lots of interest in Infrastructures having clear policies about what is required for participating services

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## WISE SCI-WG meeting - 24 Jan 2022



- Finalised draft Service Operations Security Policy template
- Discussed and agreed the next policy area requiring our attention
  - Data Protection, Privacy, GDPR etc
- Will start by performing a survey and summary of all known activities in this area
  - Update the AARC Guidance documents (G016, G042)
    - Deliverables: AARC DNA3.5 & AARC2 DNA3.1
- Decide whether (or not) to produce an updated policy framework template (or just updated guidance)
- More on this on Thursday 27 Jan 2022 at this EUGridPMA meeting

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(also take a step back looking at privacy also in other areas of the world, not just GDPR in Europe)
